There will be online prophesying sessions following each message meeting. Details will be provided in the weeks to come.

The site will interactively guide each saint to the correct language and to the correct time zone for his or her locality.

HWMR: Crystallization-Study of Deuteronomy

Week 11: Aspects of the Church Life under the Government of God

Portions from Week 11 - day 3:

The portions of Deuteronomy which deal with the divine government are the word of God, not merely the word of Moses [Deut. 16:18-20; 17:8-20; 19:15-21; 21:1-9, 18-23; 22:13-30; 24:1-4, 7, 16; 25:1-3, 5-16]. We need to study all these portions in order to know God's mind and to know what He is thinking. God knows man and man's need, condition, and situation. Therefore, whatever God speaks regarding man is the final word. The divine government among God's people is neither autocracy nor democracy but theocracy. Theocracy is government by God according to what He is. In the church life today, we exercise neither autocracy, which is a kind of dictatorship, nor democracy, which is according to the opinion of the people. Instead, we honor God's authority as our government, and thus the government in the church is a theocracy. (Life-study of Deuteronomy, p. 117)

The government in the church should be neither autocratic nor democratic but theocratic....All the saints are priests, but the elders are the leading priests. As such priests, they should stay in the Lord's presence with God's holy word and with today's breastplate—the mingled spirit with Christ and the church. As they remain in the Lord's presence with the word and the mingled spirit for the church, they will receive an understanding that is according to the Lord's thought, and this will become a decision as a kind of judgment. The elders should then administrate according to this divine judgment. Thus the elders function first as the leading priests and then as the administrators. (*Lifestudy of Deuteronomy*, p. 119)

Faith in God's Fact

The Bible shows us that Christ is our Head already. Just as a head has a feeling for the body, being responsible for it and ruling over it, Christ is the Head to us. We do not have to ask Him to be our Head and we do not have to ask to be His Body. He is the Head already, and we are His members already. This requires faith on our part.

God has given us His Son, who is responsible for us, who is living for us, and who is the power of life to us. God gave Him to us in order that all His perfection, fellowship, joy, and riches may be lived out through us. In the past, we did not understand this truth, and we tried to build up our own holiness, thereby denying God's holiness.

God is inviting us, as well as commanding us, to believe that our union with the Lord is the same as His union with God. In such a union all of His patience, meekness, purity, and goodness become ours.

All that we need to do is receive. When we believe in God's Word, we receive His grace. This is the gospel...Everything that is Christ's becomes ours through faith! By faith Christ's perfect life is lived out of our mortal body day by day! By faith it is not only "no longer I who live," but it is also "Christ who lives in me"! Beyond any doubt, Christ is living within us and for us! But this can come only by faith!
