A Word of Fellowship to All the Dear Saints in the Church in New York City

Greetings to you all! We thank the Lord for His faithfulness during these past few months as we have been facing this global pandemic of which New York City became the epicenter of the USA. We are full of thanks to the Lord that in spite of this situation, the church life has continued to advance in many aspects.

As the city enters Phase 2 of the reopening process this week, we want to let you all know that we brothers are having much and constant fellowship regarding when and how the church will be able to resume in-person gatherings. We are monitoring the situation in the city constantly, as well as having fellowship with some of the health professionals among us. The health of all the saints is our primary concern, particularly those who might be more at risk. But we also are conscious of the fact that the stay-at-home order has now been in place for some time and many saints do sense the need for inperson interaction and fellowship with others.

Although we do not yet know when we will be able to resume official church meetings in the meeting halls of the church, gatherings of 10 or less people are permitted according to the state and city guidelines, however, only with the strict adherence to CDC recommendations of social distancing and the use of face masks. The proper disinfecting of the facility and washing of hands is also recommended. The church halls could be available for gatherings of small groups of saints of 10 or less in accordance with these restrictions. But this should be carried out in fellowship and coordination with the leading brothers in each hall.

If saints are gathering in homes with other saints, of course they have the liberty to do so at their own discretion and according to the peace of Christ arbitrating in their hearts, however, we recommend that even in such a setting that the saints would exercise the necessary precautions and adhere to the CDC recommendations.

We would encourage the saints to take advantage of Camp Penuel (KPCC) during the summer months. Small groups of saints can gather there, especially outdoors, while easily adhering to the CDC recommendations.

We brothers will continue to monitor the situation and keep you all informed of any changes or progress in our fellowship as we move gradually toward in-person meetings. For the time being we encourage all the saints once again to not forsake the assembling of ourselves together via the online platforms which have been established for the church meetings and to pray for, shepherd and reach out to one another as the Lord leads. We are praying constantly for all the saints in the church, that the Lord would continue to cover us all and to take us all on so that His testimony in this city would shine brighter and brighter. Grace, mercy and peace be with you all.

HWMR: 2020 Spring ITERO "The Will of God" Week 2: Knowing and Participating in God's Great and Lofty Will to Head Up All Things in Christ

Portions from Week 2 – Day 2:

The collapse comes from the factor of death, and the rising up comes from the factor of life. When the factor of death causes a collapse, all the parts of our being become detached from one another. This is illustrated by the dry bones in Ezekiel 37. When those bones were dead and dry, they were detached. But when the breath entered into them, the became living, they rose up, and they were attached (Ezek. 37:4-10). This rising up and attaching is actually the heading up. Formerly, the bones were piled in a heap, each of them detached from the body. But when the breath of life entered into these dead bones, they firstly rose up and then became attached to one another. After this they became a body, and even an army. This is what it means to be headed up.

We should ...consider [this] in the light of our experience. Many of us can testify that we used to be detached and in the heap caused by the universal collapse. But one day the factor of life came into us, and we rose up and became attached. After coming into the church life, we had the deep sense that we were more and more upright and that we were becoming more attached. This is the heading up in Christ.
