HWMR: Crystallization-Study of Jeremiah and Lamentations

Week 8: God's Economy with His Dispensing in the Book of Jeremiah

Portion from Day 4:

Christ enacted the new covenant (which became the new testament — the will) with His blood for the redemption of the transgressions of God's people (Matt. 26:28; Heb. 9:15)... He died for us according to God's righteous requirements, and the blood He shed through that death was used to

form a covenant. Even He Himself said that the cup of the Lord's table was a symbol of the new covenant in His blood (1 Cor. 11:25). He redeemed us back to God and qualified us to inherit everything of God. This is the new covenant. Actually, this new covenant is Christ Himself. In resurrection Christ became the bequests of the new testament and the Mediator, the Executor, to execute the new testament (Heb. 9:15-17). This implies that Christ is the covenant. When God gave us the Bible as a will, this meant that God gave us Christ. Christ is the centrality and universality as the reality of the new testament. When Christ is given, that means He is the covenant. We not only have the items of the new testament in our mind, but we also have the reality of this covenant, who is Christ, in our spirit... He is the covenant of God given to us, the reality of all that God is and of all that God has given us. (*Life-study of Isaiah, pp. 338-339*)

HARMONY OF WILL (cont'd)

All of God's moves are limited by the church in time because the church represents man in eternity future... If the church comes up to the standard of God's will, He will not be limited. But if it does not come up to the standard of His will, God will be limited... Today the church is taking the position that man will take in eternity... When the church places its will under God's will today, He will move in the same way that He will in eternity; He will move as if no other will were opposing Him. This is a glory to God!

We cannot make the church so low by suggesting that it is merely a meeting. No, the church is a group of people who have been redeemed by the blood, who have been regenerated by the Holy Spirit, who have committed themselves to God's hand, and who are willing to take God's will, do His will, and stand for God on earth for the sake of maintaining His testimony.
