Monday 9/6

Eph. 1:3

3 Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us with every spiritual blessing in the heavenlies in Christ,

Eph. 2:6

6 And raised us up together with Him and seated us together with Him in the heavenlies in Christ Jesus.

Rom. 6:3-6, 8, 11

- **3** Or are you ignorant that all of us who have been baptized into Christ Jesus have been baptized into His death?
- **4** We have been buried therefore with Him through baptism into His death, in order that just as Christ was raised from the dead through the glory of the Father, so also we might walk in newness of life.
- **5** For if we have grown together with Him in the likeness of His death, indeed we will also be in the likeness of His resurrection.
- **6** Knowing this, that our old man has been crucified with Him in order that the body of sin might be annulled, that we should no longer serve sin as slaves:
- **8** Now if we have died with Christ, we believe that we will also live with Him.
- 11 So also you, reckon yourselves to be dead to sin, but living to God in Christ Jesus.

- 12 Giving thanks to the Father, who has qualified you for a share of the allotted portion of the saints in the light;
- 13 Who delivered us out of the authority of darkness and transferred us into the kingdom of the Son of His love,

- **14** And He said, Neither, but as the Captain of Jehovah's army have I now come. Then Joshua fell to the ground upon his face and worshipped. And he said to Him, What does my Lord speak to His servant?
- **15** And the Captain of Jehovah's army said to Joshua, Remove your sandals from your feet, for the place on which you are standing is holy. And Joshua did so.

Josh. 6:1-4, 6, 10, 20-21

- 1 Now Jericho was shut up so tight because of the children of Israel that no one went out and no one went in.
- **2** And Jehovah said to Joshua, See, I have given Jericho and its king and the mighty men of valor into your hand.
- 3 And you shall circle the city, all the men of valor, going around the city one time. Thus shall you do for six days.
- **4** And seven priests shall carry seven trumpets of rams' horns before the Ark. Then on the seventh day you shall circle the city seven times, and the priests shall blow the trumpets.
- **6** So Joshua the son of Nun called the priests and said to them, Take up the Ark of the Covenant, and let seven priests carry seven trumpets of rams' horns before the Ark of Jehovah.
- 10 And Joshua commanded the people, saying, You shall not shout, nor let your voice be heard, nor let a word go forth from your mouth, until the day I say to you, Shout! Then you shall shout.
- 20 So the people shouted and the trumpets were blown; and when the people heard the trumpet sound, the people shouted with a great shout, and the wall fell down flat. And the people went up into the city, each

straight ahead, and they captured the city.

21 And they utterly destroyed all that was in the city with the edge of the sword: both men and women, young and old, and oxen and sheep and donkeys.
