YOUNG WORKING SAINTS AND YOUNG FAMILIES CONFERENCE KPCC Health Guidelines*

*Guidelines subject to change

Before Arrival:

- Every participant must bring proof of vaccination OR a negative PCR COVID-19 test result:
 - Proof of COVID-19 vaccination can be shown upon arrival at the camp or emailed to northeastyws@gmail.com. If via email, please include the names of the applicable family members (including yourself).
 - PCR COVID-19 Tests should be taken within 3 days (72 hours) prior to arrival and the results brought to the camp.
- COVID-19 Vaccination is NOT required to attend. All medical information will be kept confidential and managed by the Medical team.
- A participant should NOT attend in-person if they are exhibiting any of the following symptoms:
 - Fever (>100.4 F) or chills
 - Cough
 - Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
 - Fatigue
 - Muscle or body aches
 - Headache
 - New loss of taste or smell
 - Sore throat
 - Congestion or runny nose
 - Nausea or vomiting
 - Diarrhea
- Please follow the CDC <u>guidance for travelers</u> before camp arrival to reduce exposure to COVID-19.
- Camp health guidelines are subject to change, at which time said guidelines will be updated accordingly.

Upon Arrival to Camp:

- If any symptoms mentioned above are present, participants will not be allowed to stay at the camp.

During the Conference:

- Participants are recommended to wear masks, especially when social-distancing is not possible and when serving food, transferring food, or going through the food line.

If a participant begins to exhibit any of the following symptoms, they MUST notify the First Aid Office IMMEDIATELY:

- Fever (>100.4 F) or chills
- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing

- Fatigue
- Muscle or body aches
- Headache
- New loss of taste or smell
- Sore throat
- Congestion or runny nose
- Nausea or vomiting
- Diarrhea
- After examination, the Medical team may ask the participant to leave the camp as soon as possible and within 24 hours:
 - Rapid tests will be available at KPCC
 - If the participant prefers to test off-site, they will be required to provide documentation of results to the First Aid Office
- Any participants in the same Townhouse group as the participant with symptoms will be asked to be tested and quarantined until the Medical team/KPCC receives COVID-19 test results:
 - If the COVID-19 test results are positive, unvaccinated participants in the Townhouse group may be asked to leave the camp within 24 hours; vaccinated participants will be allowed to remain at KPCC, and we will continue to monitor for symptoms.
 - If the results are negative, we will continue to monitor for symptoms.
