History of David**

**Monday 6/13**

**1 Sam. 17:45-47**

**45** Then David said to the Philistine, You come to me with sword and spear and javelin, but I come to you in the name of Jehovah of hosts, the God of the ranks of Israel, whom you have defied.

**46** On this day Jehovah will deliver you up into my hand, and I will strike you and remove your head from you. And I will give the corpses of the camp of the Philistines to the birds of heaven and to the animals of the earth on this day. And all the earth will know that there is a God in Israel;

**47** And all this congregation will know that it is not by sword or spear that Jehovah saves, for the battle is Jehovah's and He will deliver you into our hand.

**Matt. 10:29-31**

**29** Are not two sparrows sold for an assarion? And not one of them will fall to the earth apart from your Father.

**30** But even the hairs of your head are all numbered.

**31** Therefore do not fear; you are of more value than many sparrows.

**Psa. 31:14-15**

**14** But I trust in You, O Jehovah; I say, You are my God.

**15** My times are in Your hand; Deliver me from the hand of my enemies and from those who pursue me.

**Rom 8:28-29**

**28** And we know that all things work together for good to those who love God, to those who are called according to His purpose.

**29** Because those whom He foreknew, He also predestinated to be conformed to the image of His Son, that He might be the Firstborn among many brothers;

**Phil. 4:6-7**

**6** In nothing be anxious, but in everything, by prayer and petition with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God;

**7** And the peace of God, which surpasses every man's understanding, will guard your hearts and your thoughts in Christ Jesus.

**Tuesday 6/14**

**Gal. 5:17, 24, 21**

**17** For the flesh lusts against the Spirit, and the Spirit against the flesh; for these oppose each other that you would not do the things that you desire.

**24** But they who are of Christ Jesus have crucified the flesh with its passions and its lusts.

**21** Envyings, bouts of drunkenness, carousings, and things like these, of which I tell you beforehand, even as I have said before, that those who practice such things will not inherit the kingdom of God.

**Rom. 14:17**

**17** For the kingdom of God is not eating and drinking, but righteousness and peace and joy in the Holy Spirit.

**Rom. 12:18-21**

**18** If possible, as far as it depends on you, live in peace with all men.

**19** Do not avenge yourselves, beloved, but give place to the wrath of God, for it is written, "Vengeance is Mine, I will repay, says the Lord."

**20** But "if your enemy is hungry, feed him; if he is thirsty, give him a drink; for in doing this you will heap coals of fire upon his head."

**21** Do not be conquered by evil, but conquer evil with good.

**Eph. 4:26**

**26** Be angry, yet do not sin; do not let the sun go down on your indignation,

**Matt. 10:38-39**

**38** And he who does not take his cross and follow after Me is not worthy of Me.

**39** He who finds his soul-life shall lose it, and he who loses his soul-life for My sake shall find it.

**Wednesday 6/15**

**1 Sam. 24:4-6**

**4** And David's men said to him, The day is here of which Jehovah said to you, I am about to give your enemy into your hand. Do then to him according to what seems good in your sight. So David rose up and cut off a corner of Saul's cloak without being noticed.

**5** But afterward David's heart smote him because he had cut off a corner of Saul's cloak.

**6** And he said to his men, Jehovah forbid that I should

do such a thing to my lord, Jehovah's anointed, as stretch out my hand against him; for he is Jehovah's anointed.

**Phil. 3:10**

**10** To know Him and the power of His resurrection and the fellowship of His sufferings, being conformed to His death,

**Col. 1:24**

**24** I now rejoice in my sufferings on your behalf and fill up on my part that which is lacking of the afflictions of Christ in my flesh for His Body, which is the church;

**2 Cor. 4:10-12**

**10** Always bearing about in the body the putting to death of Jesus that the life of Jesus also may be manifested in our body.

**11** For we who are alive are always being delivered unto death for Jesus' sake that the life of Jesus also may be manifested in our mortal flesh.

**12** So then death operates in us, but life in you.

**Acts 13:22**

**22** And when He had deposed him, He raised up David for them as king, to whom also He testified and said, I have found David, the son of Jesse, a man according to My heart, who will do all My will.

**Thursday 6/16**

**2 Sam. 7:5, 11**

**5** Go and say to My servant David, Thus says Jehovah, Is it you who will build Me a house for Me to dwell in?

**11** Even since the time when I commanded that there be judges over My people Israel; and I will give you rest from all your enemies. Moreover Jehovah declares to you that Jehovah will make you a house.

**2 Chron. 3:1**

**1** And Solomon began to build the house of Jehovah in Jerusalem on Mount Moriah, where He had appeared to David his father, at the place that David prepared, on the threshing floor of Ornan the Jebusite.

**2 Sam 7:1-4, 12-14**

**1** And as the king dwelt in his house and Jehovah gave him rest all around from all his enemies,

**2** The king said to Nathan the prophet, See now, I

dwell in a house of cedar, but the Ark of God dwells within curtains.

**3** And Nathan said to the king, All that is in your heart go and do, for Jehovah is with you.

**4** And in that night the word of Jehovah came to Nathan, saying,

**12** When your days are fulfilled and you sleep with your fathers, I will raise up your seed after you, which will come forth from your body, and I will establish his kingdom.

**13** It is he who will build a house for My name, and I will establish the throne of his kingdom forever.

**14** I will be his Father, and he will be My son. If he commits iniquity, I will strike him with the rod of men and with the stripes of the sons of men;

#### **2 Sam. 12:10**

**10** Now therefore the sword will not depart from your house forever because you have despised Me and have taken the wife of Uriah the Hittite to be your wife.

#### **1 Cor. 10:11**

**11** Now these things happened to them as an example, and they were written for our admonition, unto whom the ends of the ages have come.

#### **2 Sam 12:9, 14**

**9** Why have you despised the word of Jehovah by doing what is evil in His sight? You have struck down Uriah the Hittite with the sword and have taken his wife as your wife and have slain him with the sword of the children of Ammon.

**14** Nevertheless, because you have given the enemies of Jehovah much occasion to blaspheme Him because of this thing, the son who is born to you shall also surely die.

#### **1 Pet. 4:1-2**

**1** Since Christ therefore has suffered in the flesh, you also arm yourselves with the same mind (because he who has suffered in the flesh has ceased from sin),

**2** No longer to live the rest of the time in the flesh in the lusts of men, but in the will of God.

#### **Psa. 51:1-2, 4, 10, 17**

**1** Be gracious to me, O God, according to Your lovingkindness; According to the greatness of Your

compassions blot out my transgressions.

**2** Wash me thoroughly from my iniquity, And from my sin cleanse me.

**4** Against You and You alone have I sinned, And I have done what is evil in Your sight. Therefore You are righteous when You speak; You are clear when You judge.

**10** Create in me a clean heart, O God, And renew a steadfast spirit within me.

**17** The sacrifices of God are a broken spirit; A broken and a contrite heart, O God, You will not despise.

#### **1 Kings 11:13**

#### **1 Pet. 3:8-10**

**8** And finally be all of the same mind, sympathetic, loving the brothers, tenderhearted, humble-minded;

**9** Not rendering evil for evil or reviling for reviling, but on the contrary blessing one another, because you were called to this, that you might inherit blessing.

**10** For "he who desires to love life and see good days, let him cause his tongue to cease from evil and his lips to speak no guile.

#### **Gal. 6:7-10**

**7** Do not be deceived: God is not mocked; for whatever a man sows, this he will also reap.

**8** For he who sows unto his own flesh will reap corruption of the flesh, but he who sows unto the Spirit will of the Spirit reap eternal life.

**9** And let us not lose heart in doing what is good, for in the proper season we will reap if we do not faint.

**10** So then, as we have the opportunity, let us do what is good toward all, but especially toward those of the household of the faith.

#### **Luke 6:36-38**

**36** Be full of compassion, even as your Father also is full of compassion.

**37** And do not judge, and you shall by no means be judged; and do not condemn, and you shall by no means be condemned; release, and you will be released;

**38** Give, and it will be given to you; a good measure, pressed down, shaken together, and running over,

they will give into your bosom. For with what measure you measure, it shall be measured to you in return.

**24** But to Him who is able to guard you from stumbling and to set you before His glory without blemish in exultation,
