

**David Typifying Christ, the Real David—the King of the Coming Kingdom of God**

**Monday 6/20**

**1 Sam 21:4, 6**

4 And the priest answered David and said, There is no common bread on hand; yet there is holy bread, but only if the young men have kept themselves from women.

6 So the priest gave him what was holy, for there was no bread there except the bread of the Presence, which was taken from before Jehovah, to be replaced by hot bread at the time it was taken.

**Matt. 1:6**

6 And Jesse begot David the king. And David begot Solomon of her who had been the wife of Uriah,

**Matt 12:1-4**

1 At that time Jesus went on the Sabbath through the grainfields. And His disciples became hungry and began to pick ears of grain and eat.

2 But the Pharisees, seeing this, said to Him, Behold, Your disciples are doing what is not lawful to do on the Sabbath.

3 But He said to them, Have you not read what David did when he became hungry, and those who were with him;

4 How he entered into the house of God, and they ate the bread of the presence, which was not lawful for him to eat, nor for those who were with him, except for the priests only?

**1 Sam. 2:35-36**

35 And I will raise up for Myself a faithful priest, who will do according to what is in My heart and in My mind; and I will build him a sure house; and he will go before My anointed continually.

36 And everyone who is left of your house will come and bow down to him for a piece of silver and for a loaf of bread, and will say, Please put me in one of the priests' offices that I may eat a morsel of bread.

**Luke 19:36-38**

36 And as He went, they spread their own garments in the road.

37 And as He was already drawing near to the descent of the Mount of Olives, all the multitude of the disciples began to rejoice and praise God with a loud voice for all the works of power which they had seen,

38 Saying, Blessed is the King who comes in the name of the Lord! Peace in heaven and glory in the highest!

**Psa. 22:1**

1 My God, my God, why have You forsaken me? Why are You so far from saving me, From the words of my groaning?

**Heb. 5:7**

7 This One, in the days of His flesh, having offered up both petitions and supplications with strong crying and tears to Him who was able to save Him out of death and having been heard because of His piety,

**Psa. 22:9-11**

9 But You are the One who drew me forth from the womb, Who made me trust while at my mother's breasts.

10 I was cast upon You from birth; From my mother's womb You have been my God.

11 Do not be far from me, For trouble is near, For there is none to help me.

**Psa. 109:3-5**

3 And with words of hatred they have surrounded me And have fought against me without cause.

4 In return for my love they have become my adversaries, But I am all prayer.

5 And they have set against me evil in return for good And hatred in return for my love.

**Matt. 27:39-44**

39 And those who were passing by blasphemed Him, wagging their heads

40 And saying, You who destroy the temple and build it up in three days, save Yourself! If You are the Son of God, come down from the cross!

41 Likewise also the chief priests with the scribes and elders mocked Him and said,

42 He saved others; Himself He cannot save. He is King of Israel; let Him come down now from the cross, and we will believe on Him.

43 He trusts in God; let Him rescue Him now if He wants Him, for He said, I am the Son of God.

44 And in the same way the robbers who were crucified with Him also reproached Him.

**Luke 23:33-35**

33 And when they came to the place called The Skull, there they crucified Him and the criminals, one on the right and one on the left.

34 And Jesus said, Father, forgive them, for they do not know what they are doing. And dividing His garments, they cast lots.

35 And the people stood by, looking on. And the rulers also sneered, saying, He saved others; let Him save Himself if this is the Christ of God, the Chosen One!

**Wednesday 6/22**

**Psa. 110:1-3, 7**

1 Jehovah declares to my Lord, Sit at My right hand Until I make Your enemies Your footstool.

2 Jehovah will send forth The scepter of Your strength from Zion: Rule in the midst of Your enemies.

3 Your people will offer themselves willingly In the day of Your warfare, In the splendor of their consecration. Your young men will be to You Like the dew from the womb of the dawn.

7 He will drink from the brook by the way; Therefore He will lift up His head.

**2 Sam. 23:1-5**

1 Now these are the last words of David: The declaration of David the son of Jesse, And the declaration of the man who has been raised up on high, The anointed of the God of Jacob, The one lovely in the psalms of Israel.

2 The Spirit of Jehovah spoke through me, And His word was on my tongue.

3 The God of Israel spoke, The Rock of Israel spoke to me, He who rules among men righteously, He who rules with the fear of God.

4 And He is like the light of the morning when the sun rises, A morning without clouds; As when the tender grass sprouts up from the earth At the sun's shining after a rain.

5 For is not my house so with God? For He has made an eternal covenant with me, Ordered in all things and secure. For all my salvation and all my desire, Will He not indeed make them grow?

**Luke 1:68-70, 76-79**

68 Blessed be the Lord, the God of Israel, because He has visited and accomplished redemption for His people,

69 And raised a horn of salvation for us in the house of David His servant,

70 Even as He spoke through the mouth of His holy prophets from of old-

76 And you also, little child, shall be called a prophet of the Most High, for you will go before the Lord to prepare His ways,

77 To give knowledge of salvation to His people by the forgiveness of their sins,

78 Because of the merciful compassions of our God, in which the rising sun will visit us from on high,

79 To shine upon those sitting in darkness and in the shadow of death, to guide our feet into the way of peace.

**Ezek. 34:23-24**

23 And I will set up over them one Shepherd, My Servant David, and He will feed them; He will feed them, and He will be their Shepherd.

24 And I, Jehovah, will be their God, and My Servant David will be a Prince among them. I, Jehovah, have spoken.

**Jer. 30:9**

9 But they will serve Jehovah their God and David their King, whom I will raise up for them.

**Isa. 32:1-2**

1 Indeed a King will reign according to righteousness, And the rulers will rule according to justice.

2 And a man will be like a refuge from the wind And a covering from the tempest, Like streams of water in a dry place, Like the shadow of a massive rock in a wasted land.

**Luke 1:31-33**

31 And behold, you will conceive in your womb and bear a son, and you shall call His name Jesus.

32 He will be great and will be called Son of the Most High; and the Lord God will give to Him the throne of David His father,

33 And He will reign over the house of Jacob forever, and of His kingdom there will be no end.

11 I am the good Shepherd; the good Shepherd lays down His life for the sheep.

**Hos. 3:5**

5 Afterward the children of Israel will return and seek Jehovah their God and David their King, and they will come with fear to Jehovah and to His goodness in the last days.

13 It is he who will build a house for My name, and I will establish the throne of his kingdom forever.

16 And your house and your kingdom will be made sure forever before you; your throne will be established forever.

**Rev. 11:15**

15 And the seventh angel trumpeted; and there were loud voices in heaven, saying, The kingdom of the world has become the kingdom of our Lord and of His Christ, and He will reign forever and ever.

**Isa. 9:6-7**

6 For a child is born to us, A son is given to us; And the government is upon His shoulder; And His name will be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Eternal Father, Prince of Peace.

7 To the increase of His government And to His peace there is no end, Upon the throne of David And over His kingdom, To establish it And to uphold it In justice and righteousness From now to eternity. The zeal of Jehovah of hosts Will accomplish this.

12 For even as the body is one and has many members, yet all the members of the body, being many, are one body, so also is the Christ.

**Col. 3:10-11**

10 And have put on the new man, which is being renewed unto full knowledge according to the image of Him who created him,

11 Where there cannot be Greek and Jew, circumcision and uncircumcision, barbarian, Scythian, slave, free man, but Christ is all and in all.

8 Ask of Me, And I will give the nations as Your inheritance And the limits of the earth as Your possession.

9 You will break them with an iron rod; You will shatter them like a potter's vessel.

**Lord's Day 6/26**

**Acts 2:22-25, 29-36**

22 Men of Israel, hear these words: Jesus the Nazarene, a man shown by God to you to be approved by works of power and wonders and signs, which God did through Him in your midst, even as you yourselves know-

23 This man, delivered up by the determined counsel and foreknowledge of God, you, through the hand of lawless men, nailed to a cross and killed;

24 Whom God has raised up, having loosed the pangs of death, since it was not possible for Him to be held by it.

25 For David says regarding Him, "I saw the Lord continually before me, because He is on my right hand, that I may not be shaken.

29 Men, brothers, I can say to you plainly concerning the patriarch David that he both deceased and was buried, and his tomb is among us until this day.

30 Therefore, being a prophet and knowing that God had sworn with an oath to him to seat One from the fruit of his loins upon his throne,

31 He, seeing this beforehand, spoke concerning the resurrection of the Christ, that neither was He abandoned to Hades, nor did His flesh see corruption.

32 This Jesus God has raised up, of which we all are witnesses.

33 Therefore having been exalted to the right hand of God and having received the promise of the Holy Spirit from the Father, He has poured out this which you both see and hear.

34 For David did not ascend into the heavens, but he himself says, "The Lord said to my Lord, Sit at My right hand

35 Until I set Your enemies as a footstool for Your feet."

36 Therefore let all the house of Israel know assuredly that God has made Him both Lord and Christ, this Jesus whom you have crucified.
