Week 6: Becoming a Reproduction of Christ as the Tree of Life for the Ministry of Life

Portion from Days 1, 2 & 4:

The Lord Jesus has set His life before us as an underwriting for us to copy by tracing and following His steps. It is not God's intention, however, that we try to imitate Christ by our own effort. We know from experience that trying to imitate Christ does not work. We are not able to imitate Him. What we need is not imitation, but reproduction...Outwardly Christ is our model, and inwardly He is our person, living in us, being formed in us, and making His home in us. Through this process we become a reproduction of the original, a reproduction of Christ as our model.

Why is Christianity so degraded? One reason is that there are many to admonish but few to give life. What can mend today's broken situation? Only the life-giving mending ministry.

In order for the Lord's life to be released from within us, we must learn to fellowship with the Lord, be subdued in our soul, and let our spirit dominate and rule over every matter. Whether we are elders or deacons or are involved in visitation or preaching the gospel, we must learn to use our spirit and to subdue our mind, emotion, and will so that we touch things with our spirit. Then the Lord's life will be able to flow out. Our supplying others with life does not depend on our doing things properly but on our exercising our spirit. MINISTRY READINGS

Salvation Being a Matter of Eating and Drinking In the Old Testament Types

In the picture of God delivering the children of Israel in the book of Exodus, He did not lift His mighty hand and pull His people out of Egypt one by one. There was not an outpouring of power from on high that delivered them out of Egypt. It was the flesh of the lamb, which they ate, that became their inward supply and strength and sustained them when they were thrust out of Egypt. They were able to leave Egypt by the strength of the food they ate.

Because there was no food, they became weary again when they reached the wilderness. However, God did not say, "Do this or do that"; rather, He sent manna from heaven and daily fed them to the full so that they had the strength to continue. When they became thirsty, God did not tell them to do this or that; instead, He cleft a rock and out came water, which quenched their thirst. Prior to reaching Mount Sinai, God's deliverance of the children of Israel [445] was altogether through eating and drinking. They ate the lamb, unleavened bread, and manna, and they drank water from the rock. This eating and drinking brought them onward in their journey. God did not command them to do anything other than eat and drink. It was their ignorance of God and of themselves that forced God to give them the law that spoke of His requirements upon them. The law was not God's original intention. His original intention was for them to enjoy Him by eating and drinking

The lamb they ate was Christ.The flesh of the lamb was eaten by the Israelites, and the blood was put on the doorposts and the lintel. The Israelites did not obtain their strength from the blood; the blood could only expiate their sins before God. It was the flesh of the lamb, which they consumed, that afforded them the strength for their journey. In the same principle, if the Son of God had shed His blood on the cross merely to redeem us from our sins, we would have received only the forgiveness of our trespasses before God. We must thank and praise Him that He also has given Himself to us. As we take Him in, He becomes our life. He is not only the Lamb who shed His blood but the Lamb who has become our food.
