HWMR: THE DIVINE DISPENSING OF THE DIVINE TRINITY FOR THE DIVINE ECONOMY

Week 6: Being a Vessel Open to the Lord and Living Ordinary Days in the Divine Dispensing of the Divine Trinity

Portions from Days 2, 3, & 6:

An open vessel is doing nothing but keeping itself open to the filling up. The processed God—the Triune God, the all-inclusive Spirit, the compound Spirit—is here waiting for an opening to get into you. How much He would enter into you depends upon how much opening you would give Him.

You just need to love Him and to keep yourself open to Him, giving Him every opportunity to do everything He wants to do. You become the enjoyer, enjoying Him and enjoying His doing. So whenever you would pray, thanks would come out of your mouth because you are so grateful to the Lord. You would experience that the Lord is your victory, your sanctification, everything to you. You will be the enjoyer of what the Lord is and of what the Lord does. (*CWWL*, 1980, vol. 1, "Perfecting Training," p. 246)

When we call on the name of the Lord Jesus, we receive the processed Triune God. To open up our mouths and call is most normal. It is normal to call "O Lord Jesus." We can call on the Lord's name in any way, at any time, and in any place. Thank the Lord for the normality of calling "O Lord Jesus, O Lord Jesus." But when we call "O Lord Jesus," do you realize what we get? We get the processed Triune God! This is miraculous. To get the processed Triune God is the top miracle, the greatest miracle among all the miracles. In order to receive Him, there is no need for me to dress up, make myself extremely neat, and be reverent by kneeling down in a proper way to pray in a formal way. There is no need for me to "wait on the Lord" for a number of days before I can contact, receive, and enjoy Him. All that I need to do is call "O Lord Jesus," and I get the processed Triune God for my enjoyment. This is the greatest miracle in this universe and the totality and absolute aggregate of all the miracles throughout all the generations. This is altogether miraculous, yet it is so normal. We can call on the Lord's name while we are driving or before we go to bed.

MINISTRY READINGS

The Meaning of Eating and Drinking God

Second, eating and drinking imply digestion and assimilation. Twelve hours after eating Brother Hwang, he will be fully digested and assimilated into me. This shows that eating and drinking include a transformation. When God is eaten by us, He becomes us.

Third, what we eat and drink becomes our inward constituent. What I eat and drink not only is digested and transformed into me, but it also becomes part of my inward constitution.In the same way, when we eat and drink God, He is digested and transformed within us to become our constitution.

Finally, what we eat and drink becomes our nutrition and nourishment, and we live by it. All the things that we eat become our nourishment and inward supply; we live by them.When we eat God, He becomes our nourishment and supply, and we can live by Him. Hence, the Lord Jesus says that he who eats Him will live because of Him (John 6:57). When we eat the Lord, He is mingled with us, digested by us, and He becomes our constitution, nourishment, and supply, enabling us to live because of Him. We can live, move, and work because we have eaten Him and have received Him into us as our nourishment and supply.
