HWMR: September 2025 International Training for Elders and Responsible Ones

WEEK 1: The Blessedness of Being Poor in Spirit and Pure in Heart That We May Be under Christ's Heavenly Ruling as Our New King and That We May See God to Express Him in His Life and Represent Him with His Authority

Portion from Days 3 & 4:

Our way of looking at God today is altogether a matter in the spirit. The God whom we may look at is the consummated Spirit, and we can look at Him in our spirit...In our morning watch, even if only for fifteen or twenty minutes, we have time to be with the Lord, time to remain in the Spirit. At such a time we may pray-read His word, talk to Him, or pray to Him with short prayers. Then we will have the sense that we are receiving something of God's element, that we are absorbing the riches of God into our being. In this way we are under the divine transformation day by day.

Our Christian life is a life not of changing outwardly but of being transformed from within by having the divine element added into our inner being to replace our old element. This is altogether

by our looking at the processed and consummated God, who is the all-inclusive Spirit.

The world is very mixed. But God's word of reality sanctifies us and makes us pure...The more a person is in the word of God, the purer he becomes. A man who is not in God's word but is in the world is complicated and impure...However, if we have God's word within, this word with God's reality will do a sanctifying work within us to separate us unto God, thus making us pure...The word of reality sanctifies us and delivers us from the mixed-up world, turning us back to the purity in God. MINISTRY READINGS

THE MINGLING OF DIVINITY WITH HUMANITY

The Lord's house in the Old Testament was first the tabernacle and then the temple. In the tabernacle and the temple there were two main materials—acacia wood and gold. The wood was overlaid with gold and united, knit together, by the gold. Forty-eight standing boards of acacia wood formed the main part of the tabernacle. All of these forty-eight boards were overlaid with gold. There were golden rings on each board which served to unite the boards (Exo. 26:24). In addition, there were bars made of acacia wood overlaid with gold running through the boards to connect them (vv. 26-29). The acacia wood signifies the human nature, and the gold signifies the divine nature. The divine nature and the human nature have to be built up together and mingled together as one. Thus, the dwelling place of the Lord, the temple of the Lord, is the mingling of divinity with humanity.
