Monday 6/22

Rev. 20:1-2

1 And I saw an angel coming down out of heaven, having the key of the abyss and a great chain in his hand.

2 And he laid hold of the dragon, the ancient serpent, who is the Devil and Satan, and bound him for a thousand years

1 Cor. 15:23-25

23 But each one in his own order: the firstfruits, Christ; then those who are Christ's at His coming;

24 Then the end, when He delivers up the kingdom to His God and Father, once He has abolished all rule and all authority and power.

25 For He must reign until God puts all His enemies under His feet.

Luke 14:14

14 And you will be blessed, because they do not have anything with which to repay you; for it will be repaid to you in the resurrection of the righteous.

Luke 20:35-36

35 But those who are counted worthy to obtain that age and the resurrection from the dead neither marry nor are given in marriage;

36 For neither can they die anymore, for they are equal to angels, and they are sons of God, being sons of the resurrection.

John 5:29

29 And will come forth: those who have done good, to the resurrection of life; and those who have practiced evil, to the resurrection of judgment.

Tuesday 6/23

Rev. 20:4-6

4 And I saw thrones, and they sat upon them, and judgment was given to them. And I saw the souls of those who had been beheaded because

of the testimony of Jesus and because of the word of God, and of those who had not worshipped the beast nor his image, and had not received the mark on their forehead and on their hand; and they lived and reigned with Christ for a thousand years.

5 The rest of the dead did not live again until the thousand years were completed. This is the first resurrection.

6 Blessed and holy is he who has part in the first resurrection; over these the second death has no authority, but they will be priests of God and of Christ and will reign with Him for a thousand years.

Rev. 2:26-27

26 And he who overcomes and he who keeps My works until the end, to him I will give authority over the nations;

27 And he will shepherd them with an iron rod, as vessels of pottery are broken in pieces, as I also have received from My Father;

Rev. 12:5

5 And she brought forth a son, a man-child, who is to shepherd all the nations with an iron rod; and her child was caught up to God and to His throne.

Dan. 7:10, 18, 22

10 A stream of fire issued forth And came out from before Him. Thousands of thousands ministered to Him, And ten thousands of ten thousands stood before Him. The court of judgment sat, And the books were opened.

18 But the saints of the Most High will receive the kingdom and possess the kingdom forever, indeed, forever and ever.

22 Until the Ancient of Days came; and judgment was given to the saints of the Most High; and the time came when the saints possessed the kingdom.

Phil. 3:11

11 If perhaps I may attain to the out-resurrection from the dead.

Rev. 19:11, 14

Psa. 68:1-4, 7-8, 20-21, 34-35

1 Let God arise; let His enemies be scattered; And let those who hate Him flee before Him.

2 As smoke is driven away, You will drive them away; As wax melts before fire, The wicked will perish before God.

3 But the righteous will rejoice; they will exult before God And be glad with rejoicing.

4 Sing to God; sing psalms to His name; Triumph in Him who rides through the deserts- For Jah is His name-and exult before Him.

34 Ascribe strength to God; His excellence is over Israel, And His strength is in the skies.

35 You are awesome, O God, from Your sanctuaries. The God of Israel, He gives strength and power to the people. Blessed be God!

Rev. 19:12, 15

12 And His eyes are a flame of fire, and on His head are many diadems, and He has a name written which no one knows but Himself.

shepherd them with an iron rod; and He treads the winepress of the fury of the wrath of God the Almighty.

2 Thes. 2:3, 7-8

3 Let no one deceive you in any way, because it will not come unless the apostasy comes first and the man of lawlessness is revealed, the son of perdition,

7 For it is the mystery of lawlessness that is now operating, but only until the one now restraining goes out of the way.

17 And whichever of the families of the earth does not go up to Jerusalem to worship the King, Jehovah of hosts, upon them there will be no rain.

16 Then justice will dwell in the wilderness, And righteousness will remain in the fruitful field;
