Prov. 9:10

10 The fear of Jehovah is the beginning of wisdom, And the knowledge of the Holy One is understanding.

Prov. 3:19

19 Jehovah by wisdom founded the earth; He established the heavens by understanding;

Prov. 8:30

30 Then I was by Him, as a master workman; And I was daily His delight, Rejoicing always before Him,

1 Cor. 1:23-24, 30

23 But we preach Christ crucified, to Jews a stumbling block, and to Gentiles foolishness,

24 But to those who are called, both Jews and Greeks, Christ the power of God and the wisdom of God.

30 But of Him you are in Christ Jesus, who became wisdom to us from God: both righteousness and sanctification and redemption,

Col. 1:16-17

16 Because in Him all things were created, in the heavens and on the earth, the visible and the invisible, whether thrones or lordships or rulers or authorities; all things have been created through Him and unto Him.

Rom. 16:25, 27

25 Now to Him who is able to establish you according to my gospel, that is, the proclamation of Jesus Christ, according to the revelation of the mystery, which has been kept in silence in the times of the ages

27 To the only wise God through Jesus Christ, to Him be the glory forever and ever. Amen.

Eph. 3:9, 11

16 Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly in all wisdom, teaching and admonishing one another with psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing with grace in your hearts to God.
