See Lord's Day

Phil. 1:20

20 According to my earnest expectation and hope that in nothing I will be put to shame, but with all boldness, as always, even now Christ will be magnified in my body, whether through life or through death.

Gal. 6:7-8

7 Do not be deceived: God is not mocked; for whatever a man sows, this he will also reap.

8 For he who sows unto his own flesh will reap corruption of the flesh, but he who sows unto the Spirit will of the Spirit reap eternal life.

Gal. 5:22-26

22 But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, long-suffering, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, **23** Meekness, self-control; against such things there is no law.

24 But they who are of Christ Jesus have crucified the flesh with its passions and its lusts.

Lord's Day 5/9

Prov. 1:1-7

1 The proverbs of Solomon the son of David, the king of Israel:

2 For knowing wisdom and instruction; For discerning words of understanding;

3 For receiving instruction in wise conduct, Righteousness, justice, and equity;

4 For giving prudence to the simple, Knowledge and discretion to the young man;

5 That the wise man may hear and increase in learning, And he who has understanding may acquire sound counsel;

6 For understanding proverb and figure, The words of the wise and their difficult sayings.

7 The fear of Jehovah is the beginning of knowledge; Fools despise wisdom and instruction.

Phil. 3:3-7

3 For we are the circumcision, the ones who serve by the Spirit of God and boast in Christ Jesus and have no confidence in the flesh,

4 Though I myself have something to be confident of in the flesh as well. If any other man thinks that he has confidence in the flesh, I more:

5 Circumcised the eighth day; of the race of Israel, of the tribe of Benjamin, a Hebrew born of Hebrews; as to the law, a Pharisee;

6 As to zeal, persecuting the church; as to the righteousness which is in the law, become blameless.

7 But what things were gains to me, these I have counted as loss on account of Christ.
