### KEY STATEMENTS

**I** Apparently, the books of 1 and 2 Kings are the history of the kings of Israel; actually, 1 and 2 Kings were written in the inspiration of the Holy Spirit in the way of being related to God's eternal economy, which is unveiled and conveyed through typology and carried out by His elect on the earth.

**II** The real Christian life for the building up of the church as the temple of God is a life of the crucified and resurrected Christ as the life-giving Spirit being built into our being so that we are being conformed to His death by the power of

His resurrection to be renewed day by day and transformed from glory to glory for His glory in the church.

**III** The glory of God—God expressed in splendor—filled the temple of God, signifying that the glory of God, intrinsically related to the economy of God and wrought into the saints, will become glory to God in the church and in Christ Jesus unto all generations, and the entire city of New Jerusalem eternally will bear the glory of God, which is God Himself shining out through the city.

**IV** The overcomers in the New Testament should be kings who have received the abundance of grace and of the gift of righteousness to reign in life; in order to reign in life, we need to be under the rulership of the Spirit, and we need to enjoy the presence of the Lord, which includes the Lord's authority, prosperity, and blessing.

### HWMR: Training Review-1 and 2 Kings

#### Selected verse and footnote:

**1 Kings 1:1** <sup>1</sup>Now when King <sup>2</sup>David was old and advanced in <sup>3</sup>years, they covered him with clothing, but he could not get warm.

#### Footnote 1, second paragraph:

The kings, as representatives of Israel, enjoyed the good land on the highest level. They are types of the New Testament believers, who were saved by God to enjoy Christ as their good land up to the level of the kingship (Rom.5:17; 2Tim.2:12; Rev. 20:4,6; 22:5b). The picture portrayed in the two books of Kings depicts in detail the character, intention, preferences, habits, morality, and actions of all the kings who reigned over Israel after David the king. Such a picture indicates that what we are, what we desire, what we intend to do, and how we behave have very much to do with our remaining in Christ and participating in all His unsearchable riches for our enjoyment. This picture concerning Israel ends with a tragedy of all the kings who were put into the blessed situation of the kingship and who were not faithful to God and did not take good care of their inheritance: they lost the good land and were carried away as captives to the idol-worshipping world. This should be a solemn alarm and warning to us in our relationship with Christ. If we were wrong in any of the matters mentioned above, we will suffer the loss of Christ as our enjoyment.
