Rom. 15:13

13 Now the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace in believing, that you may abound in hope in the power of the Holy Spirit.

John 15:11

11 These things I have spoken to you that My joy may be in you and that your joy may be made full.

John 16:24

24 Until now you have asked for nothing in My name; ask and you shall receive, that your joy may be made full.
